FL. developed to increase bookings in their units. Their Beauty of Friendship program not only offers women an opportunity to tell their female friends and family members how much they value their friendship – with a special note, small gift and makeover – it also serves as a continuous source of bookings, say Mary Ann and Darlene.

## Here's how the Beauty of Friendship works:

Mary Ann and Darlene have blank pink note cards printed with the words, "Beauty of Friendship." When each of their Consultants turns in her weekly summary sheet at the unit meeting, she receives a package of 10 Beauty of Friendship note cards.

Consultants introduce the Beauty of Friendship program to skin care class guests during the class. While waiting for the mask to dry is a great time! The consultant might say:

"Wouldn't you agree that women value friendships as on of the treasures in their lives? I know I do. The Consultant then calls the friends who were 'gifted.' When she does, she might say:

"Hello, Betty. My name is Jane Doe, an Independent Beauty Consultant with Mary Kay Cosmetics. We haven't met yet, but I've met one of your dearest friends Debbie Smith. She has a special gift for your and I have the honor of delivering it to you on her behalf.
